

RESOLUTION NO. 22-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FY 2022 NOT FOR PROFIT GRANT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT WITH NORTHWEST FEDERATED WOMANS CLUB OF BROWARD COUNTY, INC., AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE NOT FOR PROFIT GRANT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the mission of Northwest Federated Womens Club of Broward County, Inc., is to significantly improve the mental health and well-being of all members of the community through education, recreation, support, and advocacy; and

WHEREAS, the vision of Northwest Federated Womens Club of Broward County, Inc., is to provide access to quality comprehensive services that prepares a diverse community, demonstrates a global perspective in community advocacy, and engages in human and social service initiatives that enhances and builds communities with Broward County; and

WHEREAS, Northwest Federated Womens Club of Broward County, Inc., serves as a bridge between patients, physicians, and pharmacists to limit and prevent adverse prescription drug reactions for seniors and their caregivers; and

WHEREAS, the City's contribution of grant funds to Northwest Federated Womens Club of Broward County, Inc., will provide medication therapy management plans for seniors, and support services and resources such as disease management seminars to improve adherence to medication regimens, preventative care, and CPR certification, and thereby serve a legitimate public and municipal purpose;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby approves a City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2022 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement with Northwest Federated Womens Club of Broward County, Inc., ("Grant Participation Agreement"), in substantially the form attached to City Commission Agenda Memo #21-1024, and authorizes execution of the Grant Participation Agreement.

SECTION 2. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
