RESOLUTION OF THE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER AUTHORITY, AN INDEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT IN STATE **ADOPTING** OF FLORIDA: ITS OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2021, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, PACA's Board desires to adopt PACA's budget for Fiscal Year 2022 for the period commencing October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the budget is either attached to the Resolution or simultaneously accompanies the Resolution on the Board's agenda, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER AUTHORITY:

Section 1. ADOPTION.

The Board adopts PACA's operating budget for Fiscal Year 2022 which commences on October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022. The adopted budget is subject to approval of the Broward County's Commission and Fort Lauderdale's City

Commission. A copy of the budget is either attached to the Resolution or simultaneously accompanies the Resolution on the Board's agenda. 2 3 Section 2. SEVERABILITY. If any portion of this Resolution or the budget is determined by any Court to be 4 invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity 5 of the remainder of this Resolution or the budget. If any Court determines that this 6 Resolution or the budget, or any portion thereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination 8 shall not affect the applicability of this Resolution or the budget to any other individual, 10 group, entity, property, or circumstance.
