TITLE: Broward County Transportation Surtax Update - (Commission Districts

1, 2, 3 and 4)

In November 2018, Broward County electors approved a one-percent discretionary sales surtax, beginning January 1, 2019, for 30-years to increase mobility and address transportation challenges in Broward County. Each year, Broward County municipalities may submit funding applications for Municipal Capital Transportation and Mobility Projects. The Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is responsible for the application review and ranking process and Broward County determines eligibility, funding, and approval (or denial) of funding the projects.

The MPO staff will be providing an update on the Broward County Transportation Surtax program, specifically the 2022 Municipal Capital Project application process.
