TITLE: Motion Accepting a Donation of three Solar Light Poles and Light Fixtures from Affiliated Development in the Estimated Amount of \$50,884.60 -(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the City Manager to accept a donation of three (3) Solar Light Poles and three (3) Light Heads to be used as part of the City's inventory to replace broken lights in the City.

Background

Local real estate developer, Affiliated Development, wishes to donate three (3) Light Poles and three (3) Light Fixtures to the City of Fort Lauderdale. The poles were manufactured by Solar Solutions FL, LLC and are model AMRO 12-4" above grade, in black. These light poles and lights match other poles in various City locations and can be used by Facilities maintenance as part of their inventory.

Resource Impact

This action will result in a positive impact to the city. The estimated value of the donated light poles and light fixtures is \$50,884.60.
