TITLE: 2022 Legislative Update - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

The 2022 Regular Legislative Session ("Session") commenced on January 11, 2022 in Tallahassee, Florida. Session is held annually for 60-days each year. This year Session is scheduled to end on March 10, 2022. Prior to Session, the City Commission adopted the 2022 State Legislative Program, which identifies the Commission fundamental principles, resolutions, legislative priorities, and appropriation priorities. The legislative update will briefly summarize the status of specific bills having an impact on the City as of Week 5.
