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In a communication to the City Commission (attached), the Sustainability Advisory Board (SAB) recommended that the Commission and City Administration become better informed on the impacts of climate change on the insurance and mortgage markets in South Florida, the consequential implications for businesses and homeowners in the City, and the potential impact on City tax revenue.
