- **TITLE:** Resolution Approving a Request for a Special Permit to Extend Construction Hours for the Pier Sixty-Six Hotel & Marina Development Subject to the Requirements of Section 17-10 – Construction of Large or Complex Projects (Transportation and Non-Transportation) of the City of Fort Lauderdale's Code of Ordinances District - **(Commission District 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission consider adopting a resolution approving a request for a special permit to extend construction hours for the Pier Sixty-Six Hotel & Marina Development for thirteen (13) months, subject to the requirements of Section 17-10 – Construction of Large and Complex Projects (Transportation and Non-Transportation).

Background

The Pier Sixty-Six Hotel & Marina Development project is currently under construction to complete a 195 Room New Hotel, 152 Renovated Hotel Rooms, 16,000 Square Feet of Office, 17,000 Square Feet of Retail and Restaurant Use. The project (R18073) was approved by the Development Review Committee on June 15, 2019.

The applicant is requesting the extended construction hours to mitigate the impact on the neighborhoods and businesses during peak traffic hours. The project is requesting approval of the special permit to extend the hours of construction so they can continue to move forward and meet the deadlines for their contractual obligations. The Applicant anticipates the extended hours for the early morning piling activities and concrete pour to be complete within 13 months, which would further mitigate construction noise as the remaining construction activities would be internal to the structure at that point. The Applicant anticipates the project construction to be substantially complete within 24 months.

Chapter 17 – Noise Control (Section 17-7 – Specific Restrictions) limits noise related to construction activity as follows:

•	Monday – Saturday	8:00am – 7:00pm
•	Sunday	10:00am – 7:00pm

Section 17-10 - Construction of large or complex projects (transportation and non-transportation); exemption for time to comply, states the following:

A 30-day special permit (with one 15-day extension not to exceed a total of 45days) may be granted by the City Manager extending construction hours as follows:

• Monday – Sunday 6:00am – 11:00pm

The City Commission may authorize additional special permit extensions of time beyond the authority of the City Manager through adoption of a resolution upon a showing of good cause when it is demonstrated the special permit is in the best interests of public health, safety, and convenience.

The extension of time would occur two to three days a week, it would not be needed daily. The request includes the following (please see Description of Work on page 3 of Exhibit 1):

Subcontractor Work	Monday – Friday: Commence at 5 am
Auger Cast Piling and	6 am
Concrete Pours	
Concrete Pours	5 am (2-3 times/week)
Sheet Pile Impact Driver	6 am – 8 pm
