A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE REVISED AND SUBSEQUENTLY UPDATED FORT LAUDERDALE FOREIGN TRADE ZONE SCHEDULE: DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE FUTURE REVISIONS, INCLUDING CHANGES IN THE FEE SCHEDULE TO THE FOREIGN TRADE ZONE SCHEDULE; AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE FOREIGN TRADE ZONE SCHEDULE AND ANY REVISIONS THERETO TO THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY OF THE FOREIGN TRADE ZONES BOARD AND ANY OTHER NECESSARY OR PROPER OFFICIALS OR AGENCIES: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the City of Fort Lauderdale established Foreign-Trade Zone 241 (FTZ-241) on April 19, 2000, under a Grant of Authority from the Foreign-Trade Zones Board (US Secretary of Commerce and US Secretary of Treasury); and

WHEREAS, on January 4, 2000, under Resolution No. 00-1, the City Commission approved the initial Foreign Trade Zone Schedule; and

WHEREAS, On March 28, 2014, the former City Manager, submitted to the City Commission an informational memorandum 14-053 indicating changes in the fee structure to the Foreign Trade Zone Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale hereby approves the Foreign Trade Zone Schedule as set forth in City Manager Memorandum No. 14-053.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale hereby approves the revised Foreign Trade Zone Schedule as attached to Commission Agenda Memorandum No. 22-0218.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That the City Commission hereby delegates authority to the City Manager to approve changes, revisions and/or modifications to future Foreign Trade Zone Schedules, including changes to the fee schedule and further authorizes the City Manage, or his designee, to transmit such schedules to the appropriate federal, state or local officials and/or agencies.

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<u>SECTION 4</u>. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby but shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
