Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution appointing an Interim City Auditor.

Background

On February 15, 2022, the City Commission terminated the employment contract of City Auditor, John C. Herbst, with sixty days' notice. On March 15, 2022, the City Commission placed the City Auditor on administrative leave and temporarily appointed Assistant City Auditor III, Megan Gaillard, as Interim City Auditor until April 5, 2022.

Based upon the discussion at the April 5, 2022, Commission Conference Meeting, the Commission directed staff to seek out an auditing firm to serve as City Auditor on a short-term basis or until it is decided to move forward with the hiring of a new City Auditor. Staff presented two options to the City Commission that were discussed at the April 12, 2022 special meeting and the April 19, 2022 conference meeting.

Resource Impact

There is sufficient salary savings in the City Auditor's Budget to cover the anticipated expense of hiring an Interim City Auditor.
