TITLE: Resolution Authorizing Execution of a Use and Occupancy Agreement

between the Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Area Under the SE 17th Street Causeway Bridge -

(Commission District 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a resolution authorizing the execution of a Use and Occupancy Agreement ("UOA"), in substantially the form attached, between the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") and the City of Fort Lauderdale ("City") for area under the SE 17th Street Causeway Bridge.

Background

In 2002, the City entered into a twenty (20) year airspace agreement with FDOT for an area under the SE 17th Street Causeway Bridge on the east and west side of the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway (Exhibit 1). The area provides access, parking, and a park-like space (Exhibit 2). No fees were charged to the City by FDOT for this agreement. The 2002 FDOT Airspace Agreement expired on April 12, 2022. The UOA extends the real property interest for a period of twenty (20) years, at no cost to the City.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this action.
