TITLE: Motion Authorizing Acceptance of Drainage Easement Dedication by

Harbor Beach Property, LLC to the City of Fort Lauderdale - 3030 Holiday

Drive – (Commission District 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission accept the dedication of a Drainage Easement for the property located at 3030 Holiday Drive, which is owned by Harbor Beach Property, LLC and leased by the Marriott Harbor Beach Resort & Spa. If dedication is accepted, this easement will be utilized for the operation and maintenance of existing City stormwater infrastructure located within the proposed area.

Background

The City Attorney's Office ordered a title search of the property located at 3030 Holiday Drive to find all recorded easements. The title search revealed that there are no Cityowned drainage easements for existing stormwater infrastructure located in the easement area as shown in Exhibit 1.

Therefore, the dedication of the new Drainage Easement is necessary to operate, maintain, and repair City stormwater infrastructure serving the Holiday Drive right-of-way. The property owner has agreed to grant and convey a Drainage Easement to the City as described in Exhibit 1.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this item.
