This letter is to request a 12-month extension to meet the performance requirements of the Florida Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund Program for Sixt Rent A Car, LLC. Sixt's Agreement Number is SB17-107, the Project ID is 17-00102, and we are requesting the extension for Performance Year 2021. Sixt is an international mobility service provider and, due to the continued, long-lasting effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, their business has been severely impacted by the reduced number of travelers that generally utilize their services. In addition, the chip shortage, as a result of COVID-19, has limited the company's ability to acquire new vehicles for their customers. While the company does not expect to meet the project requirements for 2021, Sixt still has plans to meet the requirements of our Florida QTI agreement, but is requesting this extension of the performance metrics for 2021 due to the negative impacts of COVID-19.
