TITLE: Resolution Approving an Affordable Housing Development Agreement

Between Wright Dynasty, LLC and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Three Residential Affordable Housing Units, to Be Set Aside in Perpetuity – Wright

Dynasty, LLC - UDP-S21022 - (Commission District 3)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission consider a resolution for an Affordable Housing Development Agreement between Wright Dynasty, LLC and the City of Fort Lauderdale for three affordable housing units located at 1223 NW 6th Street and authorizing the City Manager to execute the agreement.

Background

A site plan application for the associated Wright Dynasty development was reviewed by the City Commission on May 17, 2022 (Case Number UDP-S21022) and received approval for a building height bonus of 20 feet, for a total building height of 65 feet. Pursuant to the City's Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR), Section 47-13.52.B., Performance Standards and Criteria for Additional Height Bonus, the applicant shall set-aside ten percent (10%) of all units in a development in the Northwest Regional Activity Center Mixed Use (NWRAC-MU) as affordable in perpetuity in order to receive an additional height bonus. Of the development's 24 residential units, 21 units will be market rate, and three units are to be set aside as affordable in perpetuity. The Affordable Housing Development Agreement is attached as Exhibit 1.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
