\$143,007.96 -(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the purchase of turf grass maintenance services for City cemeteries and authorize the City Manager to execute a one-year agreement with four (4) additional one (1) year renewal options with SFM Landscaping Services, LLC, in substantially the form attached, for an estimated total amount of \$143,007.96 and contingent upon appropriation of funds. Due to the volume of the work anticipated for this service and to prevent any interruption in service, staff also recommends City Commission authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Weed-A-Way, Inc., in substantially the form attached and in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 12624-523 for Turf Grass Maintenance – Cemeteries, and contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

On December 28, 2021, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 12624-523 for Turf Grass Maintenance – Cemeteries.

On January 26, 2022, the solicitation ended with eleven (11) vendors responding. Six of the eleven bidders have indicated its status as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise.

Due to the volume of the work anticipated for this service and to prevent any interruption in service, the recommendation is for the City Commission to authorize an award of multiple agreements to purchase of turf grass maintenance services for City cemeteries. The bid submitted by SFM Landscaping Services, LLC has met the specifications and requirements of the bid and deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder. The bid submitted by Weed-A-Way, Inc. has met the specifications and requirements of the bid and deemed the second lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal year impact in the amount of \$45,000. These funds are
