Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the addition of one classification to the Federation of Public Employees Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Background

<u>ADD ONE CLASSIFICATION - FEDERATION OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES</u> (SUPERVISORY):

Class FS036, Fire Logistics Supervisor, Pay Grade FS08 (\$55,449.26-\$85,987.41 annually), Supervisory & Professional Category IV

If the classification of Fire Logistics Supervisor is approved, the employee will be responsible for the procurement, storage, inventory, and distribution of supplies and equipment to every division within the Fire Department. An employee in this classification will also develop and modify programs, methods, systems, and forms to promote efficient and effective operations of the Fire Logistics Bureau. The Fire Logistics Supervisor will supervise employees in the Fire Logistics Bureau including Fire Equipment Aide, Fire Equipment Specialist, and Administrative Aide.

Federation of Public Employees has no objection to this motion to add the Fire Logistics Supervisor classification to the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to add this new classification as the action taken here is to create the classification.
