## Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission reject all bids received for Cordova Road & SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection Improvements.

## **Background**

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12638-923 for Cordova Road & SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection Improvements on January 26, 2022. A total of three (3) responses were received on February 25, 2022. The original engineer's estimate for the project is \$149,753.61. Staff recommends all bids be rejected as the lowest bid received was \$217,942.41 which exceeded the initial engineering estimate by 46%.

Given recent inflation, the Transportation and Mobility Department will review the project needs to determine if it's feasible to utilize an existing Annual Contract with preestablished bid price line-item rates. Should the project need to be re-bid, City staff will work with the neighborhood to revise the project scope to fit the available budget.
