## Re: NOTICE OF TERMINATION FOR CAUSE - AGREEMENT FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAY, $4^{\text {th }}$ OF JULY (RFP No. 12607-523)

Dear Mr. MacCormick:

YOU ARE HEREBY GIVEN NOTICE that pursuant to Section VI., subsection C., Termination for Cause of the Agreement for Fireworks Display, $4^{\text {th }}$ of July between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Exposhows Inc. is terminated effective immediately.

On June 26, 2022, an email was sent from you to a member of city staff, Ms. Debbie Bylica, informing her that armed and uniformed State of California Fire Officials served a warrant at your central explosive storage site in Mojave, California seizing all of your fireworks display product ( $70,000 \mathrm{lbs}$.) scheduled to be shipped to Florida and other show sites during the weekend of June $24^{\text {th }}$ and July $1^{\text {st }}$. In your correspondence, you acknowledged that your company, Exposhows, Inc., failed to maintain a specific California State Fire permit among dozens of other licenses and permits. This resulted in your possession being confiscated and your company unable to perform and fulfill its contractual obligations of providing the Fireworks Display on July 4th. You are in repudiatory breach of contract.
Therefore, it is for cause the City of Fort Lauderdale is severing its contractual relationship with Exposhows, Inc.
