TITLE: Motion Approving a License Agreement Between Quest Workspaces 101

N.E. 3rd, LLC and the City of Fort Lauderdale, in Substantially the Form

Provided - \$127,963 (36-Month Rent) - (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a lease agreement between Quest Workspaces 101 N.E. 3rd, LLC ("Landlord") and the City of Fort Lauderdale ("Tenant") for office space (504 square feet) on the 15th floor of Tower 101 (Exhibit 1).

Background

In March 2019, the Fort Lauderdale Police Department ("FLPD") established an in-house Psychological Services Program ("PSP"). PSP provides the following services to FLPD personnel: short-term counseling, critical response intervention, crisis intervention and a variety of behavioral health trainings such as suicide prevention, post-trauma intervention and resiliency development, peer to peer wellness support, and overall wellness improvement, growth, and integration to those in need.

The FLPD PSP team consists of one (1) full-time clinical psychologist, one (1) full-time police officer assistant, and an anticipated second full-time clinical psychologist to be hired in 2023.

City staff recommends leasing three (3) office spaces from the Landlord so that PSP staff can serve FLPD clients. A summary of the lease terms is as followed:

- Lease Term Three (3) years
- Effective Date November 1, 2022, through October 31, 2025
- Rent Annual rate for new office space will be \$41,400 with an annual three percent (3%) increase.

Resource Impact

There will be no fiscal impact to the City in FY2022. Funding for Fiscal Year 2023 is contingent upon budget approval.
