- **TITLE:** Resolution Approving a Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for Runway 13-31 Pavement Sealing at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport \$371,200 (Commission District 1)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) and accepting the anticipated grant funding of up to \$371,200 for Runway 13-31 Pavement Sealing from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) and authorize the City Manager to execute a Public Transportation Grant Agreement.

Background

Based on Statewide Airfield Pavement Management Program, Pavement Condition Index (PCI) range between 86-100 is recommended for sealing to extend the pavement life. Further, it reduces the need for pavement milling and re-surfacing (Exhibit 1). Runway 13-31 is currently in good condition with an area weighted PCI value of 89.

FXE Runway 13-31 Pavement Sealing project scope of work includes but is not limited to consultant and design fees, the survey and geotechnical costs, joint construction, associated taxiway connectors, pavement markings and striping, recalculation of the pavement PCI, equipment, labor, and incidentals required to complete the FXE Runway 13-31 Pavement Sealing project. With an estimated design cost of \$464,000 FDOT is providing a PTGA in the amount of \$371,200 for up to 80% of the projected costs, and the Airport will provide a 20% match in the amount of \$92,800, which is contingent upon approval of the September 6, 2022 Consolidated Budget CAM 22-0681.

At its meeting of August 25, 2022, the Aviation Advisory Board supported staff's recommendation to accept this grant from FDOT.

Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City for the grant in the amount of \$371,200, and a grant match in the amount of \$92,800. An additional \$32,480 in project management and engineering fees will be provided from the Airport fund. These

appropriations are contingent upon the approval of the September 6, 2022 Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 22-0681.
