Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the settlement of the workers' compensation claim in the matter of Mary Lou Gillis v. City, Case No. 22-002922DAL in the amount of \$115,000.

Background

Mary Lou Gillis, a retired Police Sergeant, filed a workers' compensation claim for an injury that occurred on February 4, 2005, while in the course and scope of employment with the City, which was accepted as compensable under Chapter 440, Florida Statutes. Ms. Gillis filed litigation against the City for her injury claim on February 4, 2022.

Staff and defense counsel's evaluation of the potential financial exposure to the City determined that a settlement would provide the most cost-effective outcome. Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$115,000, subject to the approval of the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$115,000.
