CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE PUBLIC NOTICE 2022 ANNUAL AFFORDABLE HOUSING INCENTIVE REPORT

Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes (2022), as may be amended, provides that each municipality participating in the State Housing Initiatives Partnership Program shall establish an Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) and appoint at least 8 board members, but not more than 11 members, to review the established policies, procedures, ordinances, land development regulations, and adopted local government comprehensive plan to recommend specific action or initiatives to encourage or facilitate affordable housing. The AHAC is required to annually complete a review, write a report, hold a public meeting, submit its recommendations to the City Commission for acceptance, and send a final report to Florida Housing Finance Corporation.

The Affordable Housing Advisory Committee of the City of Fort Lauderdale as per Section 420.9076(4), Florida Statutes (2022), as may be amended, will present its review of the City's local housing incentive strategies and recommendations to ensure compliance with Section 420,907(4)(a-k), Florida Statutes (2022), as may be amended. The Public is invited to participate and provide comments to the AHAC before the AHAC votes to approve its final report.

AHAC's Report Summary will evaluate the implementation of Affordable Housing Incentives in the following area:

 The processing of approval of development orders or permits, as defined in Section 163.3177(6)(f)3, Florida Statutes (2022), as may be amended, for affordable housing projects is expedited to a greater degree than other projects.

 All allowable fee waivers provided for the development or construction of affordable housing.

 The allowance of flexibility in densities for affordable housing.

 The reservation of infrastructure capacity for housing for very-low-income persons, low-income persons, and moderateincome persons.

Affordable accessory residential units.

The reduction of parking and setback

 requirements for affordable housing.
 The allowance of flexible lot configurations, including zero-lot-line configura-

tions for affordable housing.
The modification of street requirements for affordable housing.

 The establishment of a process by which a local government considers, before adoption, policies, procedures, ordinances, regulations, or plan provisions that increase the cost of housing.

 The preparation of a printed inventory of locally owned public lands suitable for affordable housing.

The support of development near trans-

portation hubs and major employment centers and mixed-use developments. Other Affordable Housing Incentives will be discussed and may be included in the AHAC report.
