- TITLE: Motion Approving FY 2023 Beach Business Improvement District (BBID) Grant Participation Agreement with Winterfest Inc. - \$25,000 -(Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the FY 2023 BBID Grant Participation Agreement with Winterfest Inc., in the amount of \$25,000.

Background

At the Beach Business Improvement District Advisory Committee (BBID) regular meeting on October 10, 2022, Winterfest Inc. requested a BBID sponsorship in the amount of \$25,000 to support the Winterfest Viewing and Festival portion of the larger Winterfest Boat Parade event scheduled for December 10, 2022. The BBID Advisory Committee unanimously approved the funding request (Exhibit 1).

The Winterfest Viewing and Festival event will be located at the Las Olas Intracoastal Promenade Park on December 10, 2022, where a variety of illuminated boats will be coasting through the waterway. The proposed activities for the site will include live music, food and beverages for purchase, sponsor activations, sampling, vendor booths, children's activities boat parade viewing, live commentary of parade, and festival atmosphere. The BBID Grant Application provides further details of the event (Exhibit 2).

The estimated cost to produce this event is \$150,000. The applicant is seeking additional sponsorship to cover expenses for the event and has secured commitments from Lacroix \$5,000, Stella Artois \$10,000, Florida Panthers \$10,000, and Baptist Health \$50,000. Funds from the BBID will be used to support overall costs associated with producing the event. The allowable expenditures include fencing, security, restrooms, sanitation, cleanup, promotions, brochures, marketing, logistics, City support services such as police detail, fire and emergency services, television, newspaper, magazines, social media, entertainment, power, lighting, tents, tables as well as barricades and traffic signage.

Funding History

BBID supported and funded the 2021 Winterfest Viewing and Festival event organized by

The Beach Business Improvement District Assessment is a non-ad valorem assessment for the cost of providing beach business improvements services, facilities and programs that have a special benefit to business property located within the beach area. This proposal is consistent with the legislative determinations of special benefit found in C-06-34, Section 1.04(A)(2), Fort Lauderdale Code of Ordinances, by increasing the number of visitors to the BBID.

Reimbursement of the funds will be contingent upon an executed Grant Participation Agreement with the City. Invoices for reimbursement shall be submitted after event completion documenting the purchase and services before a payment is made. (Exhibit 3).

Resource Impact

There will be a \$25,000 Fiscal Year 2023 impact to the City in the account listed below.

This item is contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 22-0894.
