**TITLE**: Motion Approving Second Amendment to the Lease Agreement Between

Property Geek Investors, LLC and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Riverwalk Center Shops No. 108 & 112 – (Commission District 4)

### Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the second amendment to the lease agreement between Property Geek Investors, LLC ("Lessee") and the City of Fort Lauderdale ("Lessor") for Riverwalk Center Shops No. 108 & 112.

### **Background**

On November 8, 2017, the City Commission approved a five (5) year license agreement with E & J Dining, Inc. d/b/d Mr. Nick's Sub Shoppe, for Riverwalk Center garage shops No. 108 & 112 located at 155 SE 2 Street, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301 (Exhibit 1). On June 15, 2021, the lease was assigned to the Lessee.

The current lease expires on November 8, 2022 (Exhibit 2). On September 30, 2022, Lessee expressed interest in a two (2) year lease renewal to City staff.

A summary of the amended terms is as followed:

- Lease Term Two (2) year with one additional five (5) year renewal option
- Effective Date November 8, 2022, through November 8, 2024
- Rent \$27.82 triple net, \$39,841.92 annually (\$3,320.16/month) with 3% annual increases
