TITLE: Motion Approving an Event Agreement and Related Road Closure, with In-Kind Services from the City for 2023 King Holiday Parade & Multicultural Festival - (Commission District 3)

#### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an event agreement and request for a road closure with Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration Committee, Inc., in substantially the form attached, and authorize execution of the agreements by the City Manager.

Staff is requesting the City Commission to review the request of In-kind city services and advise if any are approved.

#### Background

City staff has been working closely with the event organizer regarding event topics, such as logistics, maintenance, and security as detailed below. The Police Department recommends approval of the closing of the City streets where appropriate, and event parking has been satisfactorily arranged. When applicable, amplified music was discussed, and the event organizer was advised of the noise ordinance and possible concerns.

The organizer will submit the required certificates of insurance. The organizer is requesting City Services to support the production of the event (Exhibit 2). Funding in the amount of \$48,250 is available in the Parks and Recreation Special Event Budget. \$40,000 will come from the previously allocated \$80,000 for the St. Patricks Day Parade and \$8,250 will come from the canceled Git Lit (Riverwalk) light up event. The St. Patricks Parade Committee has notified staff they plan to continue to be involved in the parade and will continue to look to raise additional funds as in previous years. The St. Patricks Parade Committee is aware their allocation from the city for this year's parade is now \$48,250 as well.

Civic and merchant associations have been notified, as appropriate, regarding events in their respective areas. Specific event details are included in each event application as attached.
