Background

The Florida Legislature meets in session every year for sixty consecutive days. This year, the Legislature will convene after the first Monday in March to perform their constitutional duty to pass a statewide balanced budget. In addition to passing a budget, the Legislature approves several policy bills affecting local government operations.

The City's Government Affairs & Economic Development Manager along with the four contract lobbyists will advocate and lobby the City's interests during the upcoming legislative session. This draft provides direction to City staff, lobbyists, and other interested parties as to the official position of the City of Fort Lauderdale regarding issues, pending legislation, and funding requests that would affect the operation of local government.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
