TITLE: Motion Authorizing an Excess Payment of \$95,555 in Utility and Service

Charges in Accordance with the Performing Arts Center Authority Lease

Agreement – (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion authorizing an excess payment of \$95,555 in utility and service charges pursuant to Section 3.5 of the Performing Arts Center Authority ("PACA") Lease Agreement.

Background

On February 6, 2018, the City Commission approved a 50-year lease for City-owned property located at 707 NE 8 Street, also known as the Parker Playhouse Theatre, with the Performing Arts Center Authority. PACA has completed the rehabilitation and renovation of the leased premises; and opened its doors to the public on September 2021. Pursuant to Section 3.5 – Utility or Service Charges of the Lease, in the event the annual fees for utility and service charges exceed \$15,000 in any fiscal year, PACA has the right to submit a written request for reimbursement.

On November 17, 2022, PACA submitted a request for reimbursement for \$95,555. As stipulated in the lease agreement the City Manager has the authority to reimburse up to \$50,000 and any amount exceeding \$50,000 will have to be approved by the City Commission.
