## **Recommendation**

Staff recommends that the City Commission adopt a Resolution (a) granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property for Rick J Burgess adjacent to 711 Cordova Road, Fort Lauderdale, FL for (i) a 50' +/- X 8' +/- marginal dock and appurtenant steps and (ii) a 14' +/- X 10' +/- four (4) post boat lift and (b) authorizing execution of a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants relative to the dock permit.

### **Background**

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property in accordance with Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances for the installation, use, repair and maintenance of a proposed marginal dock, boat lift, and access stairs adjacent to 711 Cordova Road. Per Resolution 19-205, the application fee of \$1500 is waived for permit holders whose docks were removed by the City due to the seawall construction.

Pursuant to Code Sec. 8-144 (1) (a) the applicant is required to execute a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants relative to the Dock Permit. The Resolution authorizes the proper City officials to countersign the Declaration.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval (9:0) of the application (see **Exhibit 3**).
