# Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion for an agreement, in substantially the form attached, with Greater Fort Lauderdale Pride, Inc. for Pride of the Americas Parade and Festival 2023.

### **Background**

On November 10, 2022, the Parks and Recreation Department Parks and Recreation staff received the application for the Pride of the Americas Parade and Festival 2023 event, produced by Greater Fort Lauderdale Pride, Inc. This event contains road closures on the barrier island for the parade, followed by a festival with DJ's, live entertainment, and vendors at Las Olas Intracoastal Promenade Park.

Where applicable, the City Commission authorizes amplified music for the events listed herein.

Authorization for the execution of the event agreement is contingent upon the City Attorney's Office receiving and approving a validly executed agreement.
