- **TITLE:** Motion Approving a Services Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the Fort Lauderdale Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) - (Commission Districts 2 and 3)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Board of Commissioners approve a Services Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the CRA for fiscal years starting October 1, 2022 through the sunset date for each CRA and authorize the Executive Director to execute the Agreement.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale will provide staff and services which are needed to carry out the mission of the CRA. The roles and services provided by the City of Fort Lauderdale are outlined in the Services Agreement (Exhibit 1).

The Services Agreement complies with the Northwest-Progresso-Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Plan and the Central City Community Redevelopment Plan, as the services provided allow the CRA to implement the goals and objectives of each plan.

Resource Impact

The CRA will reimburse the City up to \$2,323,673 within the Services Agreement for FY 2022/2023. This amount may vary for each subsequent fiscal year.
