**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution amending Resolution 14-62 to authorize the City Manager to execute interlocal agreements, and approve and execute amendments, modifications, reinstatements, addenda, extensions of time, and other documents, related to Broward County Transportation System Surtax-funded projects, on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

**Background**

On November 6, 2018, the electors of Broward County, Florida, approved a local one percent discretionary sales surtax for thirty-years to increase mobility and address transportation challenges in Broward County.

The delegation of authority to the City Manager to execute interlocal agreements, and approve and execute amendments, modifications, reinstatements, addenda, extensions of time, and other documents, related to Broward County Transportation System Surtax-funded projects, on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale, will result in expedited processing times.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
