| TITLE: | Motion Approving the Purchase of Sludge Dewatering Polymer - Polydyne Inc \$442,800 - ( <b>Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4</b> ) |  |

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the purchase of a Sludge Dewatering Polymer from Polydyne Inc. for an initial one-year term amount of \$442,800 and authorize the City Manager to approve three (3) one-year renewal options, in the estimated renewal annual amount of \$442,800, for a potential total contract amount of \$1,771,200, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

### **Background**

The George T. Lohmeyer Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility (GTL) incorporates the use of seven belt filter presses to dewater biosolids captured at the plant for treatment at a residuals management facility (RMF), or for disposal at an approved landfill. GTL disposes of approximately 52,000 tons of biosolids per year. The process of biosolids dewatering includes the addition of polymer to enhance the separation of the biosolids and water. The cost of hauling the biosolids is greatly reduced using polymer in the process.

On January 24, 2023, the Procurement Services Division issued an Invitation to Bid, Solicitation Event No. 28. The bid due date was extended to entice competition since at the time of opening there was only one offer. Market outreach was conducted with two potential bidders that showed interest in the event and had responded to the previous bid. One of the potential bidders was able to supply the approved polymer but chose not to bid at this time. The other potential bidder indicated supplies were not immediately available at this time. The sole bid submitted by Polydyne Inc. meets the bid requirements and is deemed the low, responsive, and responsible bidder. Polydyne Inc. did not indicate their status as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise.

#### **Resource Impact**

There will be a current fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$258,300 for FY 2023. Future expenditures are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.
