- **TITLE:** Resolution (a) Approving an Application for a Dock Permit for Usage of Public Property by Andrew and Amy Shook adjacent to 1109 Cordova Road for a proposed 65'+/- X 10'+/- floating dock, access platform, and appurtenant gangways and (b) Authorizing Execution of a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants **(Commission District 4)**

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends that the City Commission adopt a Resolution (a) granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property adjacent to 1109 Cordova Road, Fort Lauderdale, FL for a proposed 65'+/- X 10' +/- floating dock, access platform and appurtenant gangways and (b) authorizing execution of a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants relative to the dock permit.

#### **Background**

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a dock permit for use by private persons of public property in accordance with Section 8-144 of the Code of Ordinances for the use, repair and maintenance of a proposed floating dock, access platform and gangways adjacent to 1109 Cordova Road. Per Resolution 19-205, an application fee of \$1500 is associated with obtaining a dock permit.

Pursuant to Code Sec. 8-144 (1) (a) the applicant is required to execute a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants relative to the Dock Permit. The Resolution authorizes the proper City officials to countersign the Declaration.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval (11:0) of the application (see Exhibit 3).
