# **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve Consent to Assignment and Assumption Agreement, in substantially the form attached, for Refuse and Recycling Carts, Semi-Automatic from Schaefer Systems International, Inc. (SSII) to Schaefer Plastics North America, LLC (SPNA).

### **Background**

On April 20, 2021, the City awarded Contract No. 12492-813 (three-year with two (2) one-year renewals) to SSII for semi-automated refuse and recycling carts (Commission Agenda Memo #21-0349).

On April 29, 2022, SSII separated their plastics division within the Schaefer Group and changed their company name to SPNA.

Section N of the Agreement between the City and SSII states in part: "Neither this Agreement nor any interest herein shall be assigned, transferred, or encumbered without the written consent of the other party."

Staff is hereby requesting approval by the City Commission to accept the assignment from SSII to SPNA.
