PLEASE TAKE NOTICE. The City of Fort Lauderdale will convene a public hearing to receive input on a proposed Second Amendment to the Housing and Community Development 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan and a First Amendment to the 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA). These amendments will be made in accordance with the City's Substantial Change Policy as approved by the U.S. Department of housing and Urban Development (HUD). Any changes in assisted activities due to the addition or cancellation of a program, or a change in the purpose, scope, location, or beneficiary of an activity, funding allocation, require an amendment to the Annual Action Plan.

The Amendments to the respective plans are as follows:

1. The Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program will be amended for plan years 2022-2023 to reallocate unspent funds in the amount of \$668,573.00 and award said funds to Broward House, Inc. for fourteen (14) additional Facility Based housing beds to serve eligible HOPWA persons in Broward County.

2. The Community Development Block

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The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Services program will be amended for plan years 2021-2021 and 2022-2023 to reprogram funds forfeited by Jack and Jill Children's Center in the amount of \$62,000.00 and award those funds to HOPE South Florida Inc. for Housing Case Management Services. A total of \$36,525 will be reprogrammed from plan year 2021-2022 and \$25,475 will be reprogrammed from plan year 2022-2023.

Citizens are encouraged to review the proposed Second Amendment to the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan and the First Amendment to the 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan and provide written comments.
