

RESOLUTION NO. 23-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS AND EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT ENTITLED FEDERALLY FUNDED SUBAWARD AND GRANT AGREEMENT FOR DR-4673 – HURRICANE IAN AND ALL MODIFICATIONS TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AS A PASS-THROUGH ENTITY FOR THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS), has provided grants for communities to respond to and recover from major disasters or emergencies and for limited mitigation measures from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”); and

WHEREAS, the USDHS has awarded the State of Florida funds to reimburse municipalities for Hurricane Ian expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale (“City”) has submitted claims in the amount of \$176,200.00 to FEMA for Hurricane Ian; the estimated amount the City will receive is \$132,150.00 in Federal funds from FEMA and \$22,025.00 from the State of Florida. The City is expected to bear its share of the costs in the amount of \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the amount of total grant funding and recovery amounts are contingent upon the USDHS and State of Florida’s review and appropriation of each individual project worksheet or obligation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is delegated the authority to execute a grant agreement entitled Federally Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement for DR-4673 – Hurricane Ian from the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is delegated the authority to execute any additional grant agreements or modifications with the State of Florida related to Hurricane Ian.

SECTION 3. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage.
