- TITLE: Resolution Declaring the City's Official Intent to Reimburse Itself from the Proceeds of the Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds Water and Sewer Improvements (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution declaring the official intent of the City of Fort Lauderdale to reimburse itself from bond proceeds of not to exceed \$575 million for funds advanced by the City for certain capital expenditures for water and sewer improvements.

Background

On February 7, 2023, the City Commission adopted a resolution authorizing the execution of a Comprehensive Agreement among the City, Prospect Lake Water, L.P., Prospect Lake Holdings, L.P., and IDE PLCWC, Inc., and a Labor Services Agreement Between the City and PLCWC O&M, LLC for the development, construction and operation of the Prospect Lake Clean Water Center.

This resolution is being adopted to comply with certain requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that govern the process for such reimbursements.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
