TITLE: Resolution Designating Alternative Locations for Public Meetings of the City

Commission and Advisory Boards and Committees and Designating Alternative Locations for Posting of Notices – (Commission Districts 1, 2,

3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution designating alternative locations for public meetings of the City Commission and advisory boards and committees, and for the designation of alternative locations for the posting of notices.

Background

On April 12, 2023, the City of Fort Lauderdale experienced heavy localized flooding resulting in substantial damage to City Hall which has rendered the building inaccessible. Certain provisions of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, Code of Ordinances, Unified Land Development Regulations, ordinances, and resolutions require certain public meetings be conducted at City Hall and that certain notices be posted at City Hall.

City of Fort Lauderdale Ordinance No. C-23-23, scheduled to be adopted by the City Commission on June 6, 2023, amends the City of Fort Lauderdale Code of Ordinances and Unified Land Development Regulations to provide for the designation of alternative locations other than City Hall to hold City Commission meetings, board and committee meetings, as well as alternative locations for posting of public notices in the event City Hall is inaccessible by resolution adopted by the City Commission. The proposed resolution designates alternative locations for public meetings and notice postings.

Resource Impact

There will be no current fiscal year impact to the City.
