TITLE: Presentation - Electric Vehicle Charging Ordinance Concepts -
(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4)

On January 10, 2023, the City of Fort Lauderdale Commission received a Communication from the Sustainability Advisory Board recommending the creation of an ordinance to require the installation of infrastructure supporting electric vehicle (EV) charging in new developments. In its communication, the SAB said that the proposed ordinance would support the Commission's net-zero goals adopted in 2021 (CAM 21-1121). The City Commission instructed staff to investigate ordinances providing incentives for the installation of EV charging infrastructure.

Staff has conducted a thorough review of the current and projected growth of electric vehicles within the City and their corresponding charging needs. Staff also held outreach meetings with the Downtown Development Authority and other townhouse and single-family home developers. This presentation will review the insights gained from this work and will provide the Commission with an introduction to the concepts under consideration.
