

RESOLUTION NO. 23-206

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND RATIFYING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND FORT LAUDERDALE POLICE LODGE # 31, FOP - POLICE OFFICERS AND SERGEANTS, FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2023, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026, AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT.


WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Fort Lauderdale and the bargaining agent of Fort Lauderdale Police Lodge # 31, FOP - Police Officers and Sergeants, have reached agreement on a proposed collective bargaining agreement for the period beginning October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale employees who are members of the bargaining unit represented by Fort Lauderdale Police Lodge # 31, FOP - Police Officers and Sergeants, have ratified the proposed collective bargaining agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:


SECTION 1. That a collective bargaining agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Fort Lauderdale Police Lodge # 31, FOP - Police Officers and Sergeants, for the period October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2026, is approved and ratified in substantially the form attached to Commission Agenda Memo No. 23-0738, and the City Commission authorizes execution of the collective bargaining agreement.


