A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE A FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT ("FIND") PROJECT AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$230,000.00 FOR INSTALLATION OF ONE (1) FLOATING DOCK ADDITION TO RIVERWALK ESPLANADE PARK AND FURTHER DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY EXECUTE ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS OR INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY OR INCIDENTAL TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE PROJECT AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Florida Inland Navigation District ("FIND") can provide financial assistance for the Project Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) providing funding from FIND in the amount up to \$230,000.00 but in no event no more than 50% of the City's out of pocket costs ("Project Amount") for the City to install one (1) floating dock at Esplanade Park along the Riverwalk to increase public access for small boats (hereinafter "Project"); and

WHEREAS, In 2011, Four Docks were installed along the Riverwalk increasing public access for small boats. The floating docks are very successful as they provide waterway access to the Riverwalk and downtown daily and for special events like the Sunday Jazz Brunch; and

WHEREAS, The Project will consist of Phase II Construction activities needed to install one floating dock and two ADA accessible access ramps; and

WHEREAS, Florida Inland Navigation District financial assistance is required for the project referenced above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby delegated the authority to execute on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale, the FIND Project Agreement for one (1) floating dock addition to the Riverwalk Esplanade Park in an amount of up to \$230,000.00 but in no event no more than 50% of the City's out of pocket costs.

SECTION 2. That the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida certifies the following:

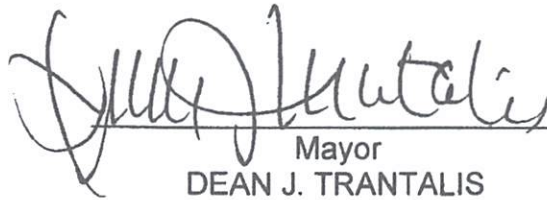
- a. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in FIND Rule 66B-2 F.A.C. and which will be a part of the Project Agreement for any assistance awarded under the attached proposal.
- b. That it is in complete accord with the attached proposal and that it will carry out the Project Agreement in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any changes has been received from the FIND.
- c. That it has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, for public use.
- d. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply with statutes relating to accessibility by persons with disabilities as well as other federal state and local laws, rules and requirements.
- e. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.
- f. That it will make available to FIND if requested, a post-audit of expenses incurred on the project prior to, or in conjunction with, request for the final 10% of the funding agreed to by FIND.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is further delegated the authority to execute on behalf of the City any other documents or instruments necessary or incidental to the administration of the FIND Project Agreement.

SECTION 4. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Commission adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City a FIND Project Agreement for a Grant award from FIND to fund 50% of the project cost for the Riverwalk Floating Dock Construction PH II, but not to exceed \$230,000. This Grant Requires a City Match of \$230,000 plus estimated internal project management fees of \$92,000. The Resolution further authorizes the City Manager to execute any and all documents or instruments reasonably necessary or incidental to administration of the Project Agreement.

Background

The Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) administers the Waterway Assistance Program (WAP) program. FIND provides funding assistance to local governments within the District to provide public access to the waterways.

In 2011, the City installed floating docks at four (4) locations along the New River to increase public access to the Riverwalk for small boats. The Project was funded in part by FIND. The floating docks are very successful as they provide waterway access to the Riverwalk and downtown daily and for special events like the Sunday Jazz Brunch. The purpose of the project is to construct one additional floating dock along the Riverwalk increasing waterway access downtown. The dock will be added to the existing floating docks at the Esplanade Park.

The project will consist of Phase II Construction activities needed to install one floating dock and two ADA accessible access ramps. Total project costs including internal project management fees are estimated at \$552,000.

The City Commission approved applying for this grant at its February 16, 2021 regular meeting.

Resource Impact

This action will result in a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$230,000 for the grant acceptance which will be appropriated to the account below contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 21-1111.

**FIND ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
PROJECT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT**

In consideration of the continuing mutual promises and covenants contained in PROJECT AGREEMENT #BR-FL-21-154 Riverwalk Floating Dock Phase II, between the FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT (F.I.N.D.) and the City of Fort Lauderdale hereafter known as the PROJECT SPONSOR. The parties hereby agree that Paragraph 2 of said certain PROJECT AGREEMENT be deleted and the following be substituted therefore:

2. **TERM** - The PROJECT SPONSOR shall not commence work on the PROJECT prior to the execution of this Agreement unless specifically authorized by the DISTRICT Board and **shall complete the PROJECT on or before September 30, 2024 and submit all required payment reimbursement information by November 15, 2024.** Pursuant to Chapter 374.976(2) F. S., the PROJECT period cannot extend beyond three (3) years from October 1, 2021, and therefore this PROJECT must be completed by September 30, 2024, unless the completion of the PROJECT has been delayed by a declared State of Emergency and the F.I.N.D. Board authorizes an extension of the completion date based upon this delay.

All other terms and conditions of the original PROJECT AGREEMENT shall remain in effect and unmodified.

This PROJECT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute but one and the same instrument. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this PROJECT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT (whether by facsimile, PDF, or other email transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Any party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other parties an original signed PROJECT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT upon request.
