Mobile vendors include a variety of products including CBD and tobacco products as well as food and beverage. The regulations prohibit mobile sales on the barrier island and the beach as well as areas outside of commercial districts and Regional Activity Centers. Vendors are only allowed to stop to make a sale. Code Enforcement and the Police Department have stepped up enforcement of mobile vendors that area operating illegally. The number of complaints has dropped substantially to almost zero. Staff will now look at the number of mobile vendors that have been licensed by the City that also sell CBD and tobacco products to see if the presence of them was a spike or an ongoing trend.
