**TITLE:** Motion Accepting Florida Department of Transportation Grant - \$83,553.33  
**(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

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**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a subgrant agreement with the University of North Florida Training and Services Institute, Inc., d/b/a Institute of Police Technology and Management (IPTM) to assist the police department in conducting a public awareness and enforcement campaign related to pedestrian and bicycle safety.

**Background**

In June 2024, the City submitted an application to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in response to a solicitation for proposals from law enforcement agencies to deliver public awareness and enforcement campaigns related to pedestrian and bicyclist safety, which is a component of Florida's Bicycle/Pedestrian Focused Initiative Communication & High Visibility Enforcement Implementation Project under the direction of FDOT and IPTM. The contract's enforcement activities are being implemented to remind and educate pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists of safe behaviors. The delivery of services must begin within 30 days of contract execution and must end on or before May 9, 2025. The grant reimburses overtime costs for specified officers who participate in the public awareness and enforcement campaign. IPTM will also provide educational materials that will be distributed to citizens as part of the public awareness and enforcement campaign.

**Resource Impact**

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$83,553.33. This item is contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM #24-0324.
