**BACKGROUND**

The proposed Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) amendment is intended to add New Year's Day (January 1) to the list of holidays that outdoor sale of holiday-related merchandise is permitted. The proposed amendment is attached as **Exhibit 1**.

**ULDR AMENDMENTS:**

Existing language in ULDR Section 47-18.15 allows applicants to obtain a license for outdoor sales of holiday-related merchandise a maximum of ten (10) days preceding the Fourth of July holiday, and a maximum of thirty (30) days preceding Halloween and Christmas. The proposed amendment adds New Year's Day (January 1) to the list of holidays that outdoor sale of holiday-related merchandise is permitted, for a maximum period of thirty (30) days preceding the holiday.

**PLANNING & ZONING BOARD REVIEW OPTIONS:**

The Planning and Zoning Board, in its capacity as the Local Planning Agency, shall determine whether the proposed amendments are consistent with the City of Fort Lauderdale's Comprehensive Plan and whether the Planning and Zoning Board recommends approval of the proposed amendments to the City Commission.
