TITLE: Motion Approving an Agreement for the NW 15th Avenue Roadway
Improvements (Surtax Project) – FG Construction, LLC – \$2,804,524 –
(Commission District 3)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the NW 15th Avenue Roadway Improvements (Surtax Project), with FG Construction, LLC, in the amount of \$2,804,524, including allowances and contingencies in the amount of \$194,000 for maintenance of traffic, and permit, and testing fees.

Background

On November 7, 2021, an Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Surtax-Funding Municipal Transportation Project, NW 15th Avenue Complete Streets Roadway Improvements (FORT-122/162) was approved, in the amount of \$2,812,805.

The NW 15th Avenue Roadway Improvements (Surtax Project) is on NW 15th Avenue from East Sunrise Boulevard to Mills Pond Park. The project scope includes roadway safety improvements which consists of but not limited to crosswalks, traffic calming improvements, ADA improvements, roadway drainage improvements, installation of concrete sidewalks within the road right-of-way, roadway signs and pavement markings, street lighting, and landscaping.

On May 6, 2024, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid Event No. 300 - NW 15th Avenue Roadway Improvements (Surtax Project). The following two (2) companies responded to the solicitation, which opened on August 2, 2024:

1. FG Construction, LLC
2. Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc.

Disadvantaged Business Enterprises was not a preference for this solicitation.

Staff reviewed the two (2) bids for compliance with the solicitation requirements and both

were deemed responsive and responsible. FG Construction, LLC is the low, responsive and responsible bidder and recommended for award.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City of \$2,804,524 for this agreement, which includes allowances for maintenance of traffic and permit and testing fees in the amount of \$95,000, and a contingency amount of \$99,000. Funds for this agreement in the total amount of \$2,804,524 are available in the FY2025 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below.
