### TAB 8 Development Plan for Leasehold Improvements

- 1. As previously stated, Mr. Campbell fully appreciates the history and character of the RIver House Restaurant and as such is not planning on redesigning the building but rather renewing, repairing and replacing the old throughout, both inside and out. The walkways, terraces, patios, windows and the kitchen will be repaired so as to retain the original character and old world charm of the 100 year old building, as far as is practically possible. It is important to note that there is equipment that will not be replaced but repaired.
- 2. The estimated time required to complete all modifications and equipment improvements is six months.
- 3. The estimated time required after completion of all modifications and equipment improvements and prior to commencement of operations is four weeks.
- 4.Improvements will Include where necessary Walkways, AC, Windows, Frames, Floors, Ceiling, Patios Carpets, Canopys, Drains Gardens Yard Electrical Upgrades.
- 5. Cost Estimate Specifically for General Repairs but not iNcludeing the Kitchen \$300,000.
- 6.Cost Estimate Specifically for Kitchen Upgrades and Repairs \$300,000.
- 7. Cost estimate for Gardens Patios Lighting Furnature \$300,000.
- 8. Cost Estimate Miscellaneous \$100,000.

### TAB 9 Operating Plan

1. American style menus will be produced concentrating on fine dining using local produce. Menus will be modified according to customer feedback. Additionally, we plan to take advantage of the beautiful tropical surroudings by offering a tea garden. Staff will be trained in all aspects of production and presentation by the executive chef. Front of house staff will be trained by the food and beverage manager.

The River House Restaurant will have its own website promoting fine cuisine and genteel ambiance and will have a link up with the concerieges in all the area hotels. In addition to this, group and tourist marketing will be maintained at all times with direct marketing to the more than 50,000 passengers Riverfront Cruise and Anticipation Yacht Charters carry each year.

2. All employees will be hired according to Florida Labor Law. State and Federal laws will be upheld at all times.

All staff will be trained on the prevention of fire and other emergency situations and on how to use defibrillatos and handle minor medical emergencies. Training will be refreshed on a monthly basis.

Daily reporting of all incidents will be mandatory.

Additionally, a state of the art CCTV (closed circuit television system) and fire monitoring and burglar system will be installed to ensure the safety of the property.

3. Mr. Campbell sees the River House Restaurant as Fort Lauderdale's jewel of southern hospitality and a showcase of traditional American style cuisine. A place where every customer will experience fine dining on the riverside that served as a trading post for Seminole trappers selling their pelts to the new settlers. The experience will be further enhanced by the elegance of the River House itself and the lush sub tropical garden in which it is shaded.

Where possible, the restaurant will be staffed by local talent and excellence will be demanded at all times. Mr. Campbell is adamant that staff, at all times, be courteous and friendly. Additionally, Mr. Campbell's other companies already employ a full-time maintenance staff which will be available to address any and all maintenance issues at this location in a quick and efficient manner daily.

4. As stated above, the competency of the staff has been a priority throughout Anticipation Yacht Charter's twenty five years in business and continues to be throughout Mr. Campbell's companies.

This ethos is compunded by careful and tight controls and conservative forecasting. In spite of the recent downturn in the economy, Mr. Campbell and his staff are expanding the yacht charter business.
