Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of pinpoint modems and hardware to CDW Government, LLC, utilizing the National (IPA) Tech Solutions Contract 130733, issued by the City of Tucson, AZ, in the amount of \$100,226.90.

Background

The pinpoint modems are required in order for patrol vehicles to have secure wireless communications which provides access to critical information on the officer laptops as well as to support planned implementation of electronic ticketing and electronic field reporting. The pinpoint modems also provide the Global Positioning System (GPS) data for the Automatic Vehicle Location (AVL) system.

Information accessed by patrol officers on their laptops includes real-time information from our dispatch center, queries to the Florida Crime Information Center (FCIC) and the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) for vehicles, license plates, suspects, articles and guns; driver license information including photos from Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV); as well as other data sources within the City and the Police department network.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$100,226.90.
