TITLE: Motion to approve Second Addendum to Revocable License with B-cycle,

LLC

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a second Addendum to the B-cycle Revocable License Agreement granted to B-cycle, LLC to add three B-cycle stations on city-owned property, and authorize the City Manager to execute the Addendum behalf of the City.

Background

On July 6, 2011, the City Commission approved a Revocable License with B-Cycle, LLC, subject to Chapter 27, Article IV, of the Code of Ordinances, to allow bike-sharing stations on city-owned property.

On September 25, 2013, the Development Review Committee reviewed B-cycle LLC's application for the addition of three stations and found it in compliance with the criteria regarding location of bicycle sharing stations as provided in Chapter 27, Article IV of the Code of Ordinances.

In accordance with the proposed Second Amendment to Permit and License Agreement (**Exhibit 1**), B-Cycle LLC is requesting to add three stations: Fort Lauderdale Beach Parking Lot, Oceanside Parking Lot and in the public right-of-way at the northwest corner of Bayshore Drive and SR A1A. Site plans and location maps for the three stations are attached as part of Exhibit 1.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

Strategic Connections

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 1: Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal City.
- Objective 2: Integrate transportation land use and planning to create a walkable and bikeable community.
- Initiative 4: Develop bike amenities.
