TITLE:	Motion to award a twenty month contract for consultant services – revenue enhancement

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a twenty month contract for revenue enhancement consultant services to ISI Water Company d/b/a Water Company of America (WCA) utilizing Pinellas County contract 112-0170-R(KR).

Background

The City provides water and sewer service for over 58,000 accounts. Each account holder pays for this service based upon information contained in the utility billing system (such as type of use, service provided, etc.) and from the field (such as water meter readings). Inevitably, a certain percentage of accounts contain incorrect information and are incorrectly billed or under billed.

Water Company of America will locate, assess and correct utility billing problems and discrepancies related to water and sewer, thereby recovering lost revenue for the City. For its work, WCA will receive a 46% proportional share of the realized increased revenue for the period of the contract. There are no other fees and there is no payment to WCA if the corrections do not result in an increase in revenue for the City.

The table below shows the total estimated increased revenue, WCA's share of the revenue, and the net amount earned by the City.

Resource Impact

The impact to the City is contingent upon the amount of additional revenue realized as a result of errors identified by WCA. Based on the estimated increased revenue, there will be a positive fiscal impact to the City for the current fiscal year in the estimated amount of \$123,750. The recognition of this additional revenue and the associated expense for this contract is contingent upon approval of the consolidated budget amendment CAM 14-0479.
