**TITLE**: Motion to award a proprietary purchase of single space parking meter

housings - \$33,016.50

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award the proprietary purchase of 150 single space parking meter housings from POM, Incorporated in the amount of \$33,016.50.

## **Background**

The Parking Services Division of the Transportation and Mobility Department currently purchases single space parking meter housings and components for meters purchased from POM, Incorporated. This purchase will allow the City to install an additional 130 meters with projected revenue of \$50,430.00 for the remainder of FY 2014. The additional meters will be added on South Andrews Avenue, south of Davie Blvd., the New River Tunnel perimeter Road, SE 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and N. Rio Vista Blvd.

POM was the contracted vendor for single space meter mechanisms that were installed in FY 2008. The housings are manufactured and sold by POM exclusively to the exact specifications for mechanisms currently in use and no other manufacturer can provide the housing without requiring the purchase of an entire new single space meter program. The City currently has over 3200 POM mechanisms in operation.

The purchase of 150 meter housings will give the City 20 spare housings that are needed for periodic replacement due to damage and vandalism. The department currently has a sufficient quantity of internal meter mechanisms to complete this installation.

## **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$33,016.50.
