TITLE: Motion to approve the award contract for the Dorsey Riverbend Sidewalk
and Curbing Project pursuant to Invitation to Bid (ITB) 343-11432 in the
amount of \$61,104

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the award of contract for the Dorsey Riverbend Sidewalk and Curbing project to the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder, Pioneer Construction Management Services, Inc., in the amount of \$61,104.

Background

The Dorsey Riverbend Sidewalk and Curbing is a Neighborhood Community Investment Program project to enhance the appearance of the Dorsey Riverbend neighborhood. The work to be accomplished under this project includes the construction of a meandering sidewalk, concrete curb and swale installation.

The project bid opening was held on August 15, 2014. Two bids were received with Pioneer Construction Management Services, Inc. submitting the lowest bid.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$61,104.
